On 14th July 2025, the students of Grade VII of Welspun Vidya Mandir undertook an educational trip to the **Welspun Sewage Treatment Plant** — a state-of-the-art facility that plays a vital role in treating wastewater from Adipur, Anjar, and Gandhidham.

The students were given an opportunity to observe the entire step-by-step process of waste water management, gaining first-hand knowledge about how science and technology work together to protect the environment.

Escorted by their respective class teachers, the students were kept safe and engaged throughout the visit. The tour not only deepened their understanding of environmental science but also highlighted the plant's significant contribution to ecological sustainability. Of particular interest to the students was the plant's innovative production of biogas and organic manure — both of which are examples of eco-friendly byproducts that support renewable energy and sustainable farming.
